Elections, Annual Membership Meeting and Potluck

Elections: Each September, Dignity/Seattle holds elections to fill vacancies on the Board of Directors. The upcoming term, October 1, 2007 to September 30, 2008 has four vacancies; three candidates are running: Paula Lavallee and Delia Vita are current board members who have agreed to run for re-election. Alan Scott is a long-time member who has placed his name into the ring. There is also room for a write-in candidate, who must be a current Dignity/Seattle member. Ballots were mailed out and you should have received one by the end of August. If you have not received one, please telephone the Dignity/Seattle information line: 206/325-7314. Elections will be held at the Annual General Meeting (information following) on Saturday, September 22nd. If you cannot attend the meeting, please mail in your absentee ballot so that it is received by Friday, September 21st.

Annual General Membership Meeting: Will be held on Saturday, September 22nd at 5:00 p.m. in the parlor at Ravenna United Methodist Church, 5751-33rd Ave NE (use side door for entry). The meeting will begin with a potluck meal, after which we will hear reports from the board, have an open discussion, and hold the election. This is a chance to meet those of us you might not know and to hear the current president and other officers give a summary of their work and state of the chapter as we head into the new fiscal year, which begins October 1st. We urge you to attend, as we need a quorum present to validate the proceedings.

Dignity USA to reinstitute \$50 membership dues October 1st

For the past few years, DignityUSA has had a "No-Minimum Dues" structure, in the hopes that a numerically larger membership would result in a larger donor base. Unfortunately, that has not been borne out. Increased donations have not made up for the elimination of dues. Therefore, during the recently concluded DignityUSA Board Meeting held in Austin, Texas in July, the Board unanimously agreed to reinstate membership dues. The exact structure of the dues (i.e., what percentage of the dues would be rebated to local chapters) has not been finalized.
