Catholics for Marriage Equality—Washington

This year's Seattle GLBT Pride Parade, one of the largest in the nation, took on special meaning, with the fate of Washington State's newly-enacted Marriage Equality Law up for a vote with Referendum 74 in November. God must have been pleased, as She blessed the celebration with sunny, mild weather in an otherwise cold, wet Seattle June.

While there were many people who toiled for decades to pass the law, especially Seattle State Senator Ed Murray, the "heroine" and one of the Grand Marshals of the Parade was Catholic Governor Christine Gregoire, who pushed for and signed the Marriage Equality Bill, and who received loud ovations along the entire route of the parade, watched by over 200,000 happy celebrants.

Of the 130 or so groups in the Parade, the largest, with 300 marchers, was Washington United for Marriage, which included Seattle Mayor Mike McGinn. Not far behind in participants, at over 200, was the Catholics for Marriage Equality—Washington (CFMEWA) contingent (which included a large sub-group from St. Joseph Parish). Included were families from throughout the state, men and women religious, Call To Action folks, Dignity/ Seattle members—the whole spectrum of self-identified Catholics who believe in justice and equality for all.


Our group, dressed in red shirts, received loud and sustained applause from the crowds along the entire 4th Ave route. As one person stated, "The crowd inspired us as much as we inspired them." One young man came up to me and said, "Thank you for marching; I'm an altar boy at St. James Cathedral." With so many diverse Catholics marching, we presented a gay— and women-supportive face of the church, which is diametrically opposite of the hierarchy's stance. It was heartwarming to see that the crowd got that. I'm sure there are a lot of people in the crowd who need not ask in the future, "Isn't being gay and Catholic an oxymoron?" or "How can you be a woman in the church? (continued on p.3)


