- PB: 30th Annual Pride Breakfast Proceeds: M/S/C: to divide the \$1540.52 Pride week breakfast net proceeds into three: \$515 for CareTeams, a Program of Samaritan Center, \$515 for Food Lifeline and \$510.52 for the Dignity Conference Scholarship Fund. \$270 will be transferred from D/S checking account to add to the totals for CareTeams and Food Lifeline to raise the amount to \$650 for each to match donations from the previous year.
- PB: Pictures are needed for the Newsletter.
- PB: The 31st Dignity/Seattle Pride Breakfast will be held next year.
- PB: The Pride Magazine needs to be contacted next year, so that the breakfast is included in their list of Pride Activities.

New Business:

Dignity/Seattle's 45th year Anniversary: Discussed celebration ideas. Delia and Alan to find a restaurant able to host 30 attendees for either October 13 or 27. Preferably the restaurant would have a separate party room and free parking. Prefer a cost per attendee of \$45 or less with any additional cost covered by Dignity/Seattle. Paula L. will coordinate the update of the Dignity/Seattle history book.

- Picnic: Alan will send out the invitation for July 28 picnic and will get all of the food along with ice and grilling essentials.
- Elections: Laure and Paula H. have expiring terms so there are two open positions. Nominations deadline is September 1. Ballots will be mailed the following week. The vote and ballot count will be at the membership meeting/potluck on September 30 at 2:00 p.m. at Delia Vita's house. The potluck will precede the meeting.
- Gender Odyssey Conference in Seattle, August 9-12.
 Focus on the needs and interests of transgender and gender diverse people including their loved ones & professionals who serve them. Dignity/Seattle has been asked to meet with DignityUSA's Danielle Walsh who will be hosting a booth at the conference. Paula L. will meet with Danielle during the conference. Discussions on hosting Danielle at a Friday evening dinner open to Dignity/Seattle members and friends.

Next Board Meeting: Wednesday, October 10, at Delia's home.
